I accepted an invitation to preach at a church probably 120 miles from our house, with half of the driving time on bad dirt paths. When I came to Zambia for two weeks in 1993 one of the places I preached was for this Pastor Joshua. God did some tremendous things back then in that church and the life of Pastor Joshua in spite of my poor preaching. After the pastor saw the healings and miracles, he asked me to pray for him and his wife. They had been married for five years and had no children. This is very unusual in Zambia and shameful culturally. I had heard they shortly became pregnant and a child was born. When I finally arrived at the church this time, the pastor showed me his children, which included two sets of twins! When I accepted the invitation, I didn't realize it was Pentecost Sunday. Neither did the pastor. I understand the Apostle Paul a little better when the Bible says in Acts 19:2, "...We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost." I

simply preached the scriptures about the power of the Holy Spirit in believers, never telling them exactly what to do. The Holy Spirit fell on us with great joy. The thing I remember most was the Pastor standing on the masonry up front (like a narrow mourner's bench) and singing the most heavenly sounds, which moved the people, by their own confession, into a deeper commitment to God. I'm sure they are witnessing like never before to everyone they meet,

changing their world for Jesus Christ. The church people told me they never get visitors like me because of the remoteness. Your partnership made it possible for me to travel where others don't go and see villages reach higher spiritual levels in The Kingdom of God. Seeing mighty and miraculous works of God makes enduring the hardships of travel (getting stuck and dealing with breakdowns) not at all a dreaded thing. I enjoy the challenge like playing sports.



Many times I look back at where I managed to drive in an old vehicle and thank God for His provision and privilege. I really believe through our partnership, God has provided the best "tools" for His work at a fraction of the cost.

God did it again this past week! The School of Ministry (MOT-MOT) was in Monde Monday through Friday. This is an area that grows a lot of tomatoes and vegetables. That means the pastors and church leaders attending class are

working in the dark morning and evening hauling water in buckets and caring for the vegetables. The Lord always sees our sacrifices and rewards us. Several times spontaneous prayer broke out. Other times a quiet hush filled our classroom (the church not yet roofed). The students are completing these university level exams in half the time they previously needed. Fruit that will remain literally for generations is being produced in these classes. Feeling the Lords hand

as I teach these classes, and the good fellowship, makes eating nshiima together enjoyable. Every night I climb without a ladder into the upper room (tent on top of Land Rover) and sleep like a baby. It is impossible for me to share some of what the Lord is doing, like these classes, but one day you and the world will see the "harvest". Pray for us, Zambia, and Africa. The enemy of our souls is fighting like

never before against his great lose of people and territory to the Kingdom of God. Trouble has raised its ugly head in ways never seen before. By the grace of God, and the prayers and support of our partners, we know we will endure and enjoy great victories. We are blessed with four teams coming to see and work with us this year. If the Lord pulls on your heart to come, you are most welcome.


